Will my older brackets fit my new 8R tractor? Yes they will!

There are three modifications that need to be done.

- 1. A new hole needs to be drilled with a mag drill, 2" below the **TOP BACK HOLE** (see picture below) on each bracket. The steel gusset will need to be trimmed to accommodate the new hole.
- 2. The block that goes between the brackets, underneath the tractor, needs to be 5/8" wider. A new block is \$410 or you can simply add shims or washers to each side of the block for an added 5/8".
- 3. The top brace arms need to be replaced. A replacement set is \$650. The rod, nut, square washer, and remaining hardware can be reused.
